

**“I am a Child of God”**  
**Primary Sacrament Meeting Presentation Outline**

*Narrator:* “I am a Child of God” is our Primary theme this year. We have learned that Heavenly Father is really our Father, and we feel His love for us. This makes us want to stay on the path back to Him. We invite you to think about these messages with us, as we talk about what it means to be a child of God.

**January: I Am a Child of God, and He Has a Plan for Me** **Class** \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* I am a child of God, and He has a plan for me. In Romans 8:16, we read, “The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God.”

Questions:

- What is the purpose of our life here on earth?
- Heavenly Father’s plan is a plan of happiness. What blessings make you happy?
- “I know Heavenly Father knows me and loves me because \_\_\_\_\_.”

**February: The Earth Was Created for Heavenly Father’s Children** **Class** \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* The earth was created for Heavenly Father’s children. In Abraham 3:24–25, Jesus said, “We will make an earth whereon these may dwell; and we will prove them herewith, to see if they will do all things whatsoever the Lord their God shall command them.”

Questions:

- Jesus created everything in our beautiful world. “I am glad that God created \_\_\_\_\_.”
- I have been sent to earth to gain a body and to be tested. How am I passing the test?

**March: Jesus Christ Is Our Savior** **Class** \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* Jesus Christ is our Savior. In Doctrine & Covenants 43:34, Jesus said, “Hearken ye to these words. Behold, I am Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world.” Because of Christ’s Atonement, I can repent and be clean, so I can live with God again.

Questions:

- Jesus taught the gospel and set an example for us. How have you followed Jesus’ example?
- What does the Atonement of Jesus Christ mean to you?

**April: Jesus Christ Restored His Church in the Latter Days** **Class** \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* Because He loves us, Jesus Christ restored His church and the priesthood in our day. In Doctrine & Covenants 35:17, Jesus said, “I have sent forth the fulness of my gospel by the hand of my servant Joseph.” Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ appeared to Joseph Smith to restore truths that were lost. Joseph received power from God to translate the Book of Mormon.

Questions:

- What do you like most in the Book of Mormon?
- How has your life been blessed by the priesthood? (for example, baptism, confirmation, the sacrament and blessings for the sick)

**May: Prophets Teach Us to Live the Restored Gospel**

Class \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* Prophets teach us to live the restored gospel. The Old Testament prophet Amos said, “Surely the Lord God will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets” (Amos 3:7).

Questions:

- Why should we follow the prophet?
- How have you blessed when you followed the prophet?

Song: Song of your choice from the *Children’s Songbook***June: I Will Follow Heavenly Father’s Plan by Being Baptized and Confirmed** Class \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* I will follow Heavenly Father’s plan by being baptized and confirmed. Jesus said, “Come unto me, and be baptized in my name, that ye may receive a remission of your sins, and be filled with the Holy Ghost” (3 Nephi 30:2).

Questions:

- Tell about how you felt at your baptism. What do you remember about it?
- What is the gift of the Holy Ghost? How does the Holy Ghost help you?
- I can keep my baptismal covenants by \_\_\_\_\_.

**July: Families Are Part of Heavenly Father’s Plan**

Class \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* Families are part of Heavenly Father’s plan. “The Family: A Proclamation to the World” teaches us that “The family is ordained of God” (paragraph 7). Heavenly Father wants me to marry in the temple and have an eternal family.

Questions:

- How can you bring happiness to your family today?
- (Boys) What are some things you can do to be a good father someday?
- (Girls) What are some things you can do to be a good mother someday?

**August: Heavenly Father Hears and Answers My Prayers**

Class \_\_\_\_\_

*Narrator:* Heavenly Father hears and answers my prayers. In Doctrine & Covenants 112:10, Jesus said, “Be thou humble; and the Lord thy God shall lead thee by the hand, and give thee answer to thy prayers.” Heavenly Father wants me to pray to Him often—anytime, anywhere. Answers to prayers can come in many ways: through peaceful feelings, ideas in our minds, through the actions of other people, and through the scriptures.

Questions:

- Why does Heavenly Father want us to pray to Him?
- When has God answered your prayers? Possibilities include a peaceful feeling, an idea in your mind, actions of other people, or a certain scripture that answered a question you had, among others.

Song: “A Child’s Prayer” (CS, 12–13)

*Narrator:* Because we are all children of God, we know He loves us. We try to make good choices, so our lives will be blessed and we will be able to return home to our Heavenly Father. We hope you too have thought about what it means to be a child of God. We say this in the name of Jesus Christ, amen.
